MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT  
 BETWEEN  
 THE COCHISE WATER PROJECT ("TCWP")  
 AND  
 US ARMY GARRISON (USAG), FORT HUACHUCA  
 AND  
 UPPER SAN PEDRO PARTNERSHIP (USPP) EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

**SUBJECT:** Implementation of Phases II and III of Sierra Vista's Improved Irrigation Program

1. Purpose. The purpose of this MOA is to outline the responsibilities of the respective parties concerning the implementation of Phases II and III of Smart Irrigation program with Sierra Vista Subwatershed.

2. Authorities: Fort Huachuca DOD 4000.19, Paragraph 5B; Army Regulation 200-3; Public Law 108-136, Section 321.

3. Background.

a. TCWP is a 501(c)3 non-profit working within the Sierra Vista Subwatershed (SVS) to conserve groundwater and is uniquely positioned to implement water saving/credit measures.

b. Fort Huachuca has an existing contract with the USPP for off post water saving measures in order to comply with their obligations under the Endangered Species Act.

4. Responsibilities.

a. The Cochise Water Project (TCWP). TCWP will coordinate and implement the following measures within the Sierra Vista sub watershed:

(1) Install SI systems at commercial and institutional facilities in the greater Sierra Vista area such as school athletic fields, apartment complexes and retail locations. 16 installations of this size are currently planned. However, if more installations are available then they have priority over the residential installations as they are more cost effective.

(2) Install SI systems at residential homes. 375 installations are currently planned.

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(3) Monitoring program will be implemented as follows: All participating locations will provide a minimum of 12 months previous water use data as a baseline. TCWP will have remote access to water consumption data at all locations and will collate and report on water usage at each location on a bi-yearly basis.

b. US Army Garrison, Fort Huachuca

(1) Fort Huachuca shall provide \$298,179 dollars to the Upper San Pedro Partnership (USPP) through the City of Sierra Vista as the fiscal agent pursuant to an existing contract for off post water saving/credit measures.


(2) Fort Huachuca shall seek and obtain concurrence from the US Fish and Wildlife Service on the amount of acre feet in water savings from the implementation of these measures.

c. Upper San Pedro Partnership:


(1) The Upper San Pedro Partnership Executive Committee shall transfer to TCWP \$298,179 dollars received from Fort Huachuca as part of the existing environmental contract for the implementation of off post water saving/credit measures.

5. Effective date, Termination, Modification or Revision.


