

The Board of Supervisors is considering an increase in the county portion of the property tax rate\*\*. WHY? Because the value of your property has declined, so by raising the rate they can collect the same revenue as FY 2013. Your property is worth less, but you will be paying the same county property tax. If the rate is not raised the county may have to spend less, or cover spending with reserves.

The chart at the bottom was presented at the April 2, 2014 Board of Supervisors Budget Work Session. The chart is the proposed rates and the results for each rate.

The current rate is 2.6276. The County wants to increase the rate to between 2.767 (same revenue as 2013) – 3.3418 % (\$5.5 million increase). The rate is applied to your Assessed Value.

Example:      Assessed Value 2013    \$20,000      X      2.6276      =      \$525  
                  Assessed Value 2014    \$19,000      X      2.7670      =      \$525
